Legacy: How we live to leave

(Hebrews 11:1-3,6; James 1:22,25; 2:17,18b,22; 2 Corinthians 5:17-20;
Matthew 13:31,32)

Our 2026 church theme is Legacy: Live it to leave it. To live for Christ with an eternal perspective in mind, to have a lasting impact and influence today which outlives our time on earth and lives on into the future.

The obvious question then becomes – **how should we live?** How does this translate into the everyday, starting from today? In 2026, we will look at three main ways to live our legacy.

Firstly, through living out our **faith** with **works**. It's why we do what we do everyday, every day. Faith and works are inseparable, neither being complete without the other. Faith is Who and what we believe and trust in. Works is how we act and live based on Who and what we believe and trust.

Secondly, through understanding that Christian legacy living involves the **message**, the **messenger** and the **mission** (which is our ministry, our service). The message is the gospel found in the Word of God, we the Christians are the messengers, and the mission is to pass on the message (which keep it alive into the future). Each messenger must have faith in the message (faith in Jesus Himself) and a willingness and the empowering of the Spirit to carry out the mission of sharing this message.

Thirdly, through living for **growth** and **reproduction**. The message must grow in the messenger so that the messenger is able to persevere and continue with the mission. The mission is accomplished when more messengers are brought on board to carry forward and perpetuate the message. Growth leads to reproduction.

To live our legacy in this way, we have to be prepared to **show** and **tell**. We show the world what we do and we tell of Jesus who motivates and strengthens us to do it. That is the expression of faith and works. That is how the mission of the message is accomplished by the messenger. That is how growth and reproduction occurs. That is how we encourage each other to live our legacy.

If we live this way, the legacy of Christ on earth is assured. Lighthouse will leave a lasting legacy of God's goodness and grace which glorifies Him. So, let's live our legacy, Lighthouse!
