Expansion Part 1: Grow!

(Isaiah 54:2,3; Genesis 26:12-22, 28:10-16, 49:22; Matthew 13:31,32)

People in Christ who love one another and become involved in each other's lives develop deep and meaningful fellowship. True fellowship leads to a natural outcome.

Expansion.

The Lighthouse Vision, as set out in Isaiah 54:2,3 describes the essence of what our core cultural value of expansion means. Expansion in this context means Growth and Spiritual Inheritance. Our November series covers the first aspect, growth.

The Hebrew verb for "enlarge" in verse 2 is *rachab*, which conveys the idea of being broadened, widened, or given room to grow wide and large. In short, you need room to grow, and you need to make room for growth.

The Hebrew verb for "expand" (also translated as "spread out") in verse 3 is *parats*, which pictures a sudden, vigorous bursting of boundaries—physical, numerical, military, spiritual (whether walls, enemies, flocks, or national borders, or anything else that restrains). In short, to grow, you need to break down the barriers that confine you and spread out from your previous containment.

Growth, therefore, comes when we make room for it by breaking out of our current constraints through the divine work of the Holy Spirit, which powers our LIFE in Christ. Growth in our individual lives and as a fellowship. Growth in our capacity to influence people for Christ to enlarge God's kingdom, which is the Lighthouse mission.

The converse is also true. We can limit our growth and expansion, not because we lack the God-given capacity to grow, but because we have not made room to grow, nor broken free from the things that limit our growth.

The 4 H's can help us develop a Holy Spirit-powered growth orientation in Lighthouse – Head & Heart, Habit, and Habitat. If we cultivate the right desires (*Heart*) and way of thinking (*Head*), develop the right behaviours (*Habit*), and create the right environment (*Habitat*), then, by God's grace and the work of His Spirit, we will grow.

Our mission and vision are based on expansionary growth for God's glory. Because that is who and what God has called us to be. So, let's all make room and break out to grow together, Lighthouse!
