Legacy: Live it to leave it

(2 Kings 20; Zechariah 4:1-10; Matthew 13:31,32;17:20b)

In 2024, our church theme was "Come & Go," with the emphasis on God being ever-present in our lives. We come to Jesus, go with Jesus, and come and go through Jesus. This is our Christian life individually.

In 2025, our church theme was "Lighthouse United". It is our LIFE in Christ that defines our shared Godly values, our joint expression of faith as a community (our church culture), and the way we carry out our God-given mission and vision. This is our Christian life in community.

In 2026, our church theme is "Legacy", the third part of our thematic trilogy. My life, and, collectively, our lives, in and for Christ must be lived with an eternal perspective in mind. Our lives must have a lasting impact and influence that outlives our time on earth.

Let us not be like King Hezekiah. He mostly lived well for Yahweh and largely did what was right, but he did not leave a good legacy for his descendants. His son Manasseh became one of the most evil kings of Judah, and within 100 years, the kingdom had fallen to the Babylonians as a consequence of God's judgment.

Let us be like Zerubbabel, who, despite the days of small beginnings, returned from exile to rebuild the temple of God, the place of God's presence that was destroyed by the Babylonians. The end result seemed small and insignificant compared to the glorious structures of the past. But it was an act of legacy, to bring forth the cornerstone of the new temple, that resounded in eternity. Zerubbabel, from whose lineage comes Jesus Christ, the chief cornerstone who brings God's presence to us forever.

The pop-art pioneer Andy Warhol said, "The idea is not to live forever; it is to create something that will." In Christ, we have the legacy of an eternal and abundant life in Him. We must live His legacy today to leave it for the future. This is our Christian life that resounds in eternity.

My birthday wish for us is to commit to living the Legacy of Jesus so that we can leave it for future generations of Christians, in our families, in our Lighthouse community, and throughout the world. Happy birthday, Lighthouse!
