Expansion: Create A Habitat for Growth

Did God command us to expand?

Surely, God has instructed us to expand His kingdom on earth. The Great Commission of Jesus, "Make disciples of all nations..." (Matthew 28:19), is the command for the church to expand.

Lighthouse's Vision is expressed in Isaiah 54:2, "Enlarge the place of your tent, And let them stretch out the curtains of your dwellings; Do not spare; Lengthen your cords, And strengthen your stakes..." (NKJV) We are to stretch, lengthen, and strengthen as the body of Christ to expand.

Have we done enough to expand?

The verse tells us "Do not spare," which means do not limit, underestimate, and think lowly of our own abilities and capacity to expand God's kingdom on earth.

Therefore, we must pray for the enlargement of: our hearts to receive more (Psalm 119:32), for our faith to receive more (Ephesians 3:20), and for our Church, "Lighthouse", to grow more (Hosea 14:6).

Let us also create a habitat for expansion (an environment for growth).

First, we must desire and decide to expand. Follow through: We work diligently to achieve our goals and expand. The Bible tells us that it is God who causes the seeds to grow, while we diligently sow seeds and water them to create an environment conducive to growth.

Let us stretch, lengthen, and strengthen four key areas that support church expansion. These are the foundational pillars — Evangelism, Discipleship, Leaders Training, and Community Engagement.

We must cultivate a lifestyle of evangelism and assist others in growing through discipleship via life groups and ministries. Focus on leadership development by identifying potential leaders within the congregation and nurturing their skills and gifts. Hosting local events, volunteering, and supporting those in need are great ways to engage the community and demonstrate Christ's love.

So, let us put our hands to the plough together to expand the kingdom of God.
