(Philippians 2:1–5; 1 John 1:1–4; Romans 1:8–12; Hebrews 10:23–25)

A large multi-generational family gathering with many friends invited to celebrate a milestone birthday. Law firm partners with different expertise and experience working together on a large client project. A sports team in a huddle during the halftime break of a knockout game. One wizard, one elf, one dwarf, two men, and four hobbits setting off on a quest to destroy a corrupting ring (yes, it's Lord of the Rings!).

Which of these four images best represents the word "fellowship"? The full meaning of the Greek word *koinonia* which is commonly translated in the Bible as fellowship?

It's a trick question, of course. The answer is ... all of them.

Koinonia or fellowship is often reduced to a description of close family or community ties, but it is so much more than that. Koinonia means to participate, to share, to commune (as in communion), to gift or contribute. True fellowship is about the collective "us" being a community, a partnership, a team, a company. With a shared goal and a common purpose. Which we participate in and contribute to.

We share the same faith, serve the same Lord, care for each other's welfare, and contribute to one another's growth in a community of faith. We are partners in faith, working together with what each of us brings to the table, to build a better church and deliver the Kingdom projects we have been entrusted.

We approach the game of life as a champion team, playing our part and doing our best on the field, cheering and encouraging our teammates when we are on the bench. A band of brothers in arms and sisters in battle, who fight for each other, carry the wounded, commemorate the fallen, complete the quest, and accomplish the mission.

This is *koinonia*. This is fellowship. We are better together because we can only do faith properly together. We do not come together in fellowship because it is merely advantageous; we come together in fellowship because it is vitally necessary.
