## LEGACY OF FAITH AND WORKS

### ***"Pass on the flame, spread the fire"***

A legacy at Lighthouse of passing on our faith  
Deuteronomy 6:4-9, 20-25; 2 Timothy 2:2.

This Sunday we continue with the idea of leaving a Legacy at Lighthouse by passing on the flame. This flame is our faith in God. In previous weeks we talked about how God lights this flame in us, and how to keep this fire going.

To help with this imagery, I like to imagine myself to be a torch. Not a battery powered one that we often use today, but rather an old-school one used in adventure movies by people like Indiana Jones or Lara Croft while exploring dark caves or mysterious ruins. Basically, a fire on a stick you can hold. We used to be an unlit torch without Christ, but now we are on fire, and this week we are talking about passing on this flame to others, specifically in our church community.

The goal we are talking about today is to pass on our flame of faith to others here in Lighthouse, to our biological family as well as our Christian one. This is part of how we leave behind a legacy, a lasting impact and influence for God. Legacy is more than just leaving behind a memory, it is reproduction. We are leaving behind faith that lasts, even after we as individuals are gone.

So, to leave behind a proper legacy we need to be a torch that is first on fire for God. No flame can be passed on without first having faith in God. We must first believe in Christ. Now that we have faith in God and the flame is lit, we can't just sit still and hold on to our own flame. Yes, as Christians we are called to tend to our flame and our personal relationship with Christ, but our Christian walk does not stop at just our own faith. It must be passed on, from one torch to another. That is how we build Legacy.

So how do we go about passing on the flame? One thing I want to encourage us to do is talk more about God passionately. Share what God has taught us. Share about who God is, and who God is to you. Talk about what He has done for you, how He has helped you. And do this all passionately. Because passion is infectious: it creates curiosity, it makes what you're talking about interesting. If we lack this passion or desire to talk about God, we can ask God for help. Jeremiah 29:13 promises that when we seek Him with all our heart, we will find Him.

Lord God, fire up in us a passion for You, so that we can share wholeheartedly of Your goodness to those around us, influencing the people around us for You.
